immediate threats to their security and scholarly work. Welcome offers to host these scholars in temporary positions at higher education institutions in Europe, North America, and globally. IIE's statement on the Ukraine crisis can be found here. IIE has also launched a call for Emergency Student Fund nominations from IIENetwork members for international students impacted by the crisis in Ukraine.

Additionally, the Emergency Student Fund is now accepting nominations from IIE Network Member institutions for two calls:

- Nominate up to five international students who are impacted by the crisis in Ukraine.
- Nominate up to five international students who are impacted by the security and humanitarian emergency in Afghanistan.

This effort will provide onetime grants of between \$2,000 and \$5,000 to selected students whose ability to pay the costs of their academic year 2021-22 in the United States is in jeopardy due to serious financial difficulties related to these crises. Funding for asylum seekers: The WH Revis Article 26 Scholarship: Students who are seeking asylum in the UK may not be eligible for home funding and therefore face a significant barrier to obtaining a University education. Article 26 was a project of the Helena Kennedy Foundation set up to help address this issue. In support of this project The University of Nottingham is offering one award consisting of the full international undergraduate fee plus £500 per year towards living costs to the successful applicant.
