Working Group on International Criminal Law
Meeting of 24 October 2007

Dov Jacobs held a presentation ‘Introduction on the Special Tribunal for Lebanon’, which touched upon geopolitical and legal issues, such as the definition of terrorism. The presentation was followed by a discussion on the issues raised in the presentation.

Finally, an initial agenda for the academic year 2007/2008 was agreed on, and the coordinators introduced a proposal to organize a conference on issues of the International Criminal Court and international criminal justice.

The next meeting was scheduled for 5th December 2007, with a presentation by Jaques Hartmann. (*Due to the absence of many members of the Working Group, including the presenter, the meeting was later cancelled*). It was initially agreed that the third meeting of the Working Group will take place on 16th January, and Patricia Pinto Soares will hold a presentation on the relationship of the International Criminal Court and the Security Council. (*The meeting was later postponed to 23rd January*).
