

The Master in European Union Policy Studies of James Madison University in Florence guarantees priority in the selection process to MWP fellows with competences in line with JMU's teaching needs. Courses can be team-taught. Fellows are requested to use state-of-the-art, interactive teaching methods and are constantly followed, in order to improve their performance. Grading methods and paper tutoring as well as assessment skills are developed in conjunction with academic coordinator Caterina Paolucci. Fellows receive professional feedback on their performance and an overall written evaluation of their teaching skills by the end of the course. Moreover, MWP Fellows can apply to teach in the undergraduate Minor in Modern European Studies Program, which started in Spring 2009. From the Summer Semester 2009, MWP Fellows can apply to give a lecture in the "EU Policy-Making" Guest Lectures Series of JMU. Fellows can also participate in the organisation and become members of the scientific committee of the joint EUI-JMU graduate symposium, taking place in June every year (This year on June 8, 2009 at Villa La Fonte).
