Goal of the MRM

The goal of the MRM is to promote high-quality, original and innovative research, both theoretical and empirical, in law, history, economics and across the social sciences on key themes and topics related to the Middle East, North Africa, Southern and South-Eastern Europe, and their relations with Europe.
