The goal of the MRM is to promote high-quality, original and innovative research, both theoretical and empirical, in law, history, economics and across the social sciences on key themes and topics related to the Middle East, North Africa, Southern and South-Eastern Europe, including their mutual relationships and relations with Europe.



Workshop Directors

Each workshop will be jointly run by two workshop directors who should come from different institutions and have different national backgrounds.

Ideally, at least one director should be based in the Middle East, North Africa, or South-Eastern Europe.

Applications should be made jointly by two directors.
