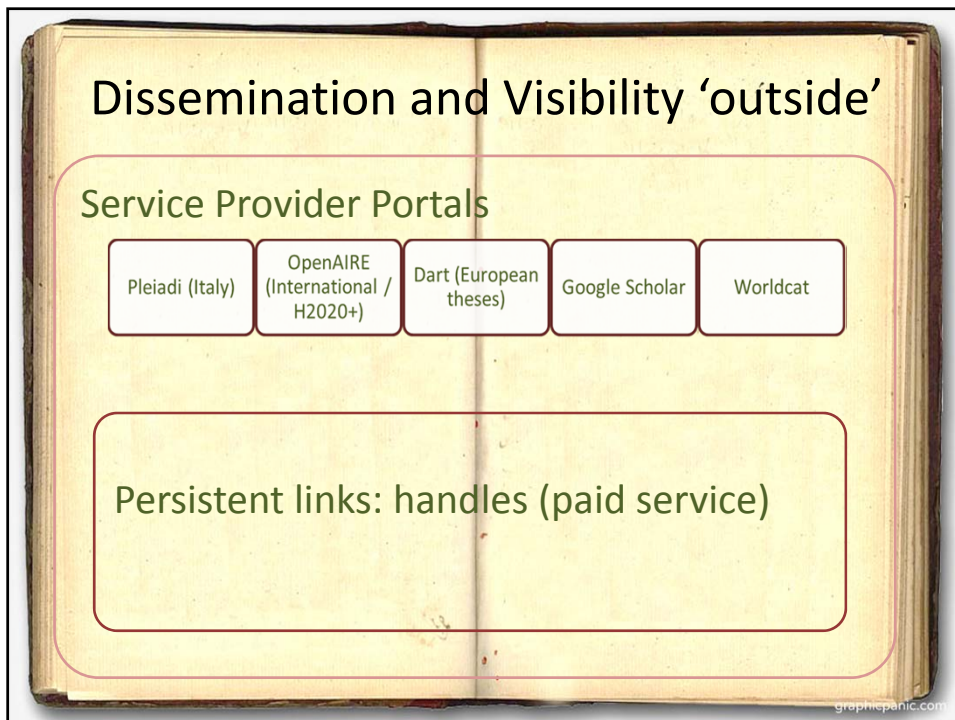
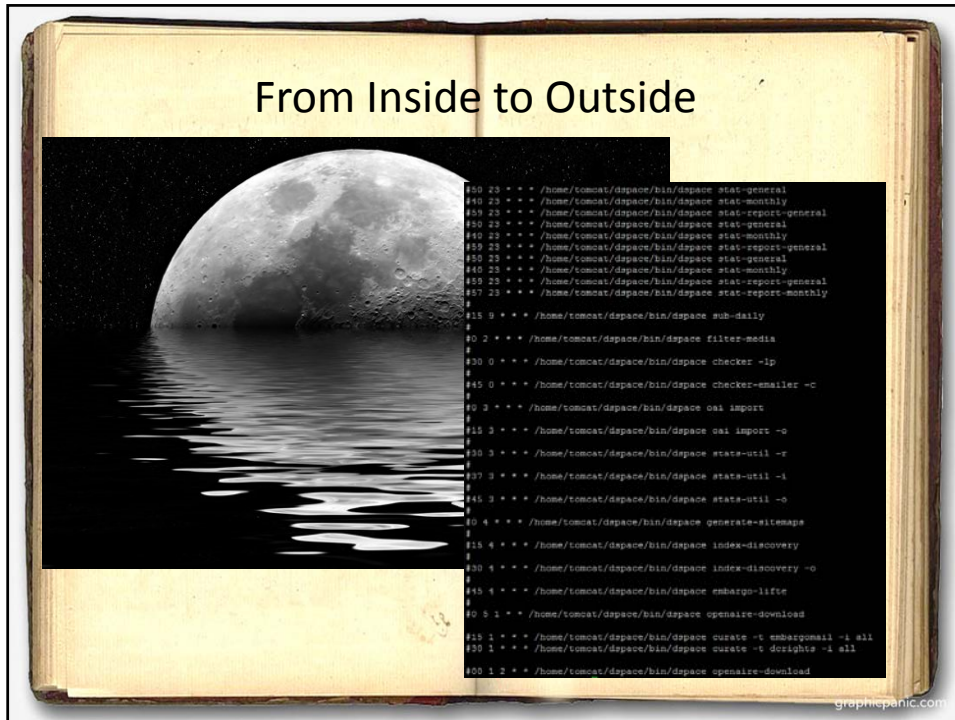
**“Cadmus as dissemination tool”:



The life of Cadmus: an overview




The diagram illustrates the timeline of Cadmus, starting with its 'Birth' in 2003. Key milestones include the adoption of various DSpace versions (1.x.x, 1.2.2, 1.4.2, 1.6 XMLUI, 1.8.2 XMLU, 5.2 XMLUI, 6, and 7 or New software?). 
