EFS organises annually a Conference at EIB headquarters in Luxembourg on matters of European interest, in particular on policy issues that are relevant to the Bank. The conference proceedings are published in the EIB papers. Recent EIB papers present research on energy, industrial policy, public-private partnerships, foreign direct investment, and Europe's changing financial landscape.
