

Decision of The Principal n° 13/09
of 5 May 2009

concerning the repayment of EUI researchers' debts

The Principal

Having regard to the increasing number of debts left unpaid by researchers both during their stay at the EUI and at the time of departure from the EUI,

Considering the need to ensure that all researchers leaving the EUI have respected all obligations towards the Library and other services of the Institute,

Considering the need to establish precise regulations to be applied by all services and academic departments of the EUI for the repayment of researchers' debts,

Having regard to the Decision of The Principal no. 4 of 21 February 2006, setting out the methods of payment for advances on EUI research students' grants,

Having regard to the Decision of The Principal no. 6 of 5 March 2008, concerning the repayment of EUI researchers' debts.

Has decided:

In the following cases, where:

- advance grant payments have not been repaid within the time limits set out in the above-mentioned decision
- Library fines have not been paid within the set time limits
- books have been taken out on loan and not returned
- rents and bills for apartments let by the EUI have not been settled
- fees for registering a child/children at the EUI crèche have not been settled by a set date,

1. Admission to, and registration for, the successive year of study will be conditional on unpaid debts being settled at the latest by 30 June of the current academic year.
2. The doctoral, LL. M. or M. Res. diploma, or any certificate concerning the researcher's academic activities during his/her stay at the Institute, will not be issued until all relevant services have confirmed that the researcher has fulfilled all his/her obligations in respect of the current regulations.

This decision annuls and replaces decision n°6 of 5 March 2008.
