## **Blogs as information providers**

- Blogs
  - websites usually maintained by an **individual** with regular entries of commentary.
  - Most blogs are interactive, allowing visitors to leave comments and even messages.
- What happens when defamation claims are raised?
- Recent decisions of the Italian lower courts adopted a criticized approach where
  - → BLOGS = NEWSPAPERS
  - **⇒** BLOGGERS = NEWSPAPER EDITORS

## Consequences

- Same obligation to monitor and select content to be published
- Same standard of liability in case of negligence for bloggers and editors
- Problems
  - → Lack of specific rules applicable to the blogosphere
    - ⇒ Current (piecemeal and overlapping) legislation could not be interpreted so as to allow such analogy.
  - Should bloggers be treated differently with regards to ISPs?
    - ⇒ Allocation of liability on those who are more easily identifiable
