

Carlotta Sorba

Carlotta Sorba is Professor of Cultural History at the Department of History at the European University Institute History and Professor of Modern History at the Department of History, Geography and the Ancient world, University of Padua (Italy). She gained a doctorate in Contemporary History from the University of Turin after two scholarships in Geneva and in Paris at the French CNRS.

She is the founder and since 2012 has been the director of the CSC (*Centro Interuniversitario di Storia culturale*), the result of a convention between the Universities of Padua, Bologna, Venice, Pisa, Verona and Salerno (<http://centrostoriaculturale.org>) in order to develop and enhance cultural history studies in Italy. The Centre is now part of a European network of cultural history (METIS <https://wp.unil.ch/metis/presentations-des-centres/>) which includes the *Centre d'Histoire culturelle des sociétés contemporaines* - CHCSC (Université Paris Saclay) and the *Centre des sciences historiques de la culture* - SHC (Université de Lausanne).

She has held numerous positions of responsibility at her university: she has been one of the coordinators of the Padua University Scientific Committee (2016 - 2020 for the section of History, Geography, Philosophy) and a member of numerous University Boards for Gender studies and policies. From 2016 to 2018 she was a member of the National Committee for ASN (Abilitazione Scientifica Nazionale).

She has carried out intense organisational activity in the scientific community. She has served and is currently serving on the editorial boards of several scientific journals, such as "Contemporanea. Rivista dell'800 e del 900", "Revue d'Histoire du XIXème siècle", "Revue d'Histoire culturelle". She has also worked intensely at the organization of conferences, seminar cycles, summer schools, within and outside of the framework of the CSC. In 2017 she was the coordinator of the scientific board for the biennial Sissco Conference (Cantieri di storia 2017), the main meeting for contemporary history scholars in Italy.

As a specialist in the history of 19th-century Italy, in 2021 she was appointed by the Ministry of Cultural Activities to the steering committee of the "Istituto per la storia del Risorgimento italiano" in Rome. Since 2019 she has sat on the board of the *Association for Political History* (APH) and she is organising the Eight international APH PhD Conference in Padua due to be held in June 2023 (7-9 June 2023).

She is editor of three Italian publishing collections: "Storia delle donne e di genere" (Viella); "Studi culturali. Concetti e pratiche" (ETS); "I tempi e le forme" (Carocci).

She has been visiting professor at numerous European universities: the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens; the Ecole Normale Supérieure de la rue d'Ulm, Paris; the Université Lyon 2; the Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne; the Fondation Maison de Science de l'Homme; the Université Paris Saclay; and the Ecole Pratique des Hautes Etudes, Paris.

Since 2001, she has conducted intensive post-doctoral tutorship and supervision of doctoral theses. She currently supervises five doctoral students: three at the University of Padua, one at the University of Malta and one in co-tutorship with the Université Jean Moulin Lyon 3.

She conducts extensive historical dissemination activities. For several years she has participated in the cycles of *History Lessons* organised by the publisher Laterza. Since November 2022, she has been a member of the scientific committee of the television programme 'Passato e presente' (Rai storia).

Research areas

Carlotta Sorba is a cultural historian of 19th-century Europe with special research interests in the relationship between cultural production (music, theatre, proto-mass culture), society and politics. She has published extensively on Italian and European 19th-century history and particularly on theatre as a physical, social and imaginative space and as a breeding ground for social and cultural representations.

She has authored over 100 scholarly publications, including 4 monographs, 7 edited or coedited volumes, articles and book chapters in the area of 19th-century cultural history, theatre and society, gender history, material culture, the cultural history of politics, nationalism, history and cultural theory. Her book *Politics and sentiments in Risorgimento Italy. Melodrama and the Nation* (Laterza 2015; Palgrave Macmillan 2021) was awarded the Senior prize by the Italian Society for Studies on Contemporary History (Sissco 2016).

Her current research focuses on the material culture of politics (objects and clothing) during the 19th century. On this topic, she recently edited *The clothing of politics. Dress, appearances and political identities (19th-20th centuries)*, special issue of “Contemporanea”, 4, 2017; and *Political Objects in the Age of Revolution. Material Culture, National Identities, Political Practices*, with Enrico Francia, Viella 2021.

Her scholarly work has also developed around the methodological aspects of the cultural turn in history and the relationship between history and cultural theories.
