I. The Foundations of Transnational Governance

Offers perspectives on the actors, structures and practices of transnational governance and how informal and formal rules and regulation impact “beyond the state” and transform national political systems.

II. Tools of Transnational Governance

Provides the legal and statistical language necessary to understand the effects and impacts of transnational governance, as well as a learning platform to design future tools for dealing with them.

III. Economics

Drives learning about the essential economic insights to understand economic transformations and the consequences of specific regulatory solutions.

IV. Professional Development

Offers a broad range of practical skills ranging from negotiation to policy design, including leadership, project management skills, gender mainstreaming, and much more. Students will gain professional development skills training and other technical competencies to succeed in their careers.

V. Specialisation Track

This module is a great opportunity for the students to specialise within the programme. Students choose two seminars that decide their area of specialisation.

VI. Free Elective

Students complement their specialisation area by freely choosing two elective courses from the rich offer of transnational governance courses available.

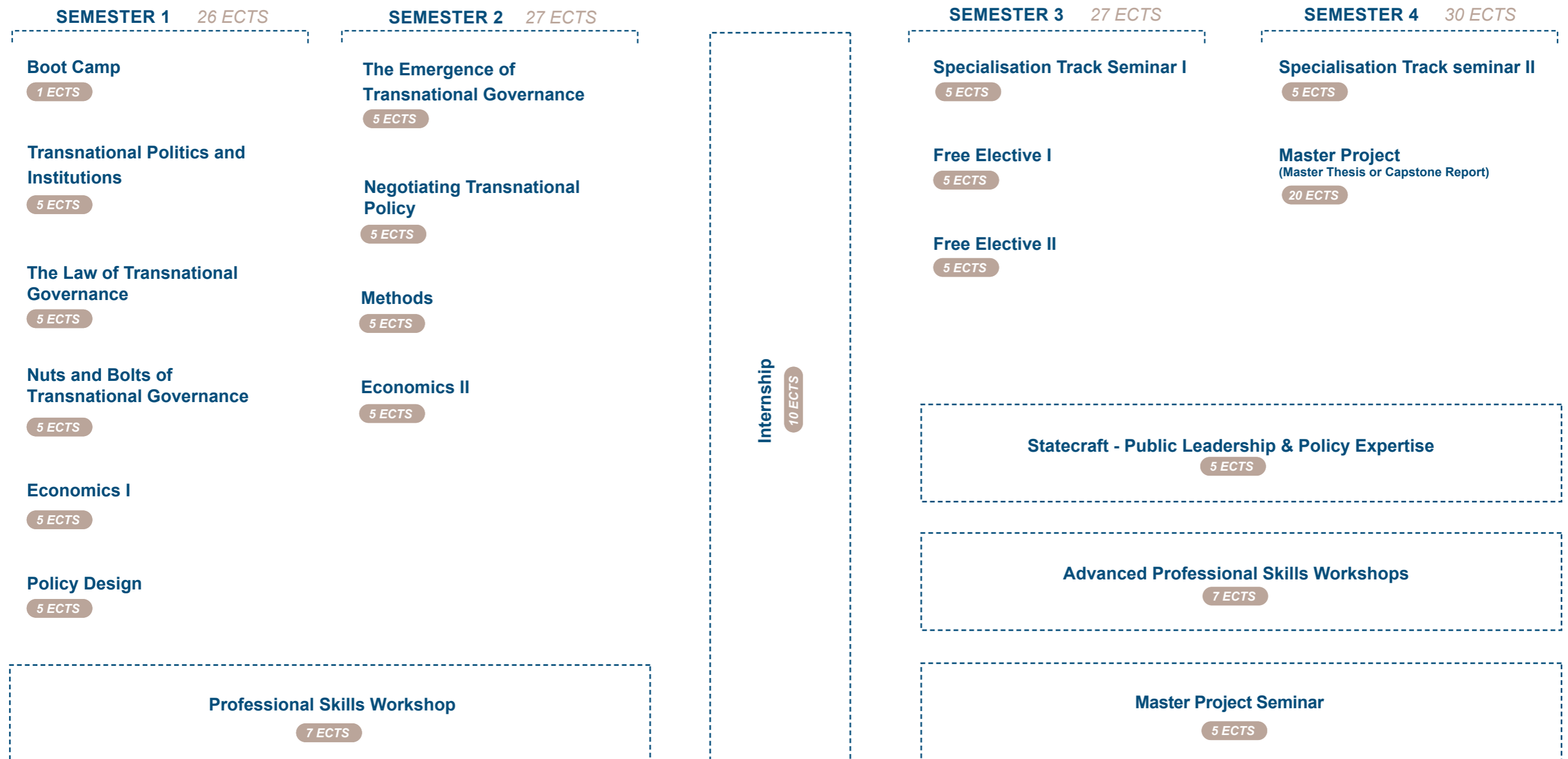
VIII. Master Module
