Advanced Block I – 2009-2010

Provides further tools to tackle micro / applied questions. The course will provide the student further understanding regarding discrete choice models, panel data techniques and duration models. The course will be taught mainly from slides and will look at practical implementations of these techniques in the literature. The course will not be overly technical, but requires a good understanding of the previous econometrics courses.

The exam will be a take-home exam. The students have to find some micro-data and apply one of the techniques seen during the course and write a small essay (max 5 pages) which describes the economic question, the data set, the method chosen to tackle the question and the results.
