

Pascal Vennesson is professor of political science, chair “Security in Europe”, at the European University Institute, Robert Schuman Center for Advanced Studies. <http://www.eui.eu/SPS/People/Faculty/CurrentProfessors/bioVennesson.shtml>. He is on leave from the University Panthéon-Assas, Paris II (France) as Full Tenured Professor (Professeur Agrégé des Universités, 1ère classe).

Professor Vennesson’s research field is International Relations, International Security Studies, European security, and the European Union’s external relations. He has recently initiated several research projects on the European Union’s multi faceted involvement in Northeast Asia.

Professor Vennesson was a fellow at Stanford University’s Center for International Security and Arms Control, at Ohio State University’s Mershon Center and a *Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique* (National Center for Scientific Research) fellow at Harvard University’s Belfer Center for Science and International Affairs, John F. Kennedy School of Government. He is a member of the editorial boards of *La Revue Française de Science Politique* (*The French Political Science Review*), and *Security Studies*.

In 2009 and in 2010 Professor Vennesson was a team member for the European Report on Development, a major initiative promoted and financed by the European Commission and some European Union Member States. He also served in the French Ministry of Defense from 1999 to 2003 as Professor and Director of the Center for social science studies of defense (*Centre d’études en sciences sociales de la défense-Secrétariat général pour l’administration*) where he was responsible for promoting policy-relevant social science research on a wide range of defense and security issues.

He received his MA from the University Paris I Panthéon-Sorbonne and his Ph.D. from *Sciences-Po* Paris (1992).
