

## **Workshop: Ethnographic and ‘Qualitative’ Data Collection**

This course provides an overview for data collection using qualitative methods. Focus is placed on ethnography and in-depth qualitative interviews. Key principles characterising these methodologies will be considered, both on a theoretical and applied manner. Works that use these methodologies will be read and discussed in detail, while as part of the course, participants will conduct a practical exercise of qualitative data collection. After choosing a general topic at the class- or small-group level, they will have to conduct an in-depth qualitative interview and write a short-ethnographic observation of a relevant social setting. All this will culminate to the development of a research proposal. At the end of this workshop, students will have familiarised themselves with designing and implementing data collection using qualitative methodologies. Simultaneously, they will be able to assess the methods of data collection when reading research projects using such methodologies.
