





- Position instead of scholarship
- Funding: DAAD-support via funding agreement with employing German university
- Conditions:
- all nationalities, all disciplines, all destinations
- no age restrictions

P.R.I.M.E. – Postdoctoral Researchers International Mobility Experience

- Duration: 18 months work contract at German university...
- mobility phase abroad: 12 months
- > (re-)integration phase in Germany: 6 months






P.R.I.M.E. – Postdoctoral Researchers International Mobility Experience

Funding:

- Salary (according to public sector pay scale TV-L 13)
- Expatriate allowance (depending on country of destination)
- Travel allowance
- **Success rate:** ~10-20 %
- Important dates
- Call for applications announced: 16 November 2015
- Application Deadline: 1 February 2016
- Earliest starting date for funding: 1 September 2016







P.R.I.M.E. – Selection Criteria

- Academic qualification (grades, study duration, letters of recommendation etc.)
- Publications (number, quality/impact, first authorships)
- Project (scientific quality, realistic planning, feasibility)
- Suitability of host institutions
- Other achievements:
- extra-curricular activities, social commitment;
- transnational mobility;
- personal circumstances: e.g. unavoidable delays in academic development due to child care



Research Grants

Goal: promote research projects within the context of doctoral programmes / support entire doctoral projects in Germany

- Short-term Grants
- 1-6 months
- One year Grants
- usually 7-10 months
- Long-term Grants: Doctoral Programmes in Germany
- usually max. 3 years, in exceptional cases up to 4 years

Research Grants

Eligibility

- Graduates/PhD candidates (minimum B.A., usually with M.A.)
- Postdocs (short-term and one-year grants only)

Funding

- > € 750.-/month for graduates (holding a B.A.)
- ≥ 1,000.-/month for doctoral candidates and postdocs.
- Insurance cover
- Travel allowance
- additional allowances for one-year and long-term grants

Research Stays for University Academics and Scientists

Support for short-term research stays

- Eligibility: Postdocs/(Ass.) Professors who work at a university or research institute in their home country
- Duration: 1-3 months
- Financial support:
- > € 2,000 for postdocs, assistant professors, lecturers
- ➤ € 2,150 for full professors
- Travel allowance






