13th Max Weber June Conference: Drivers and Consequences of Transformation

12-14 June 2019, Badia Fiesolana, San Domenico di Fiesole

This conference aims at creating a cross-cultural and cross-disciplinary dialogue on historical and contemporary social, economic, legal and political transformations. The goal is to reflect on the driving forces and actors of past or current events shaping societal developments and their effects.

Various dimensions of change will be explored, such as political transitions, social contestations, economic integration, cultural disjunctures, technological advancements, and socio-legal reforms.

We invite applications for the 2019 June Conference from current and former Max Weber Fellows, as well as from current Jean Monnet and Marie Skłodowska-Curie Fellows at the EUI or at other institutions.

We welcome contributions that address transformation on a methodological, empirical or theoretical level.

Conference participants are cordially invited to attend the EUI's June Ball, held on the last day of the conference.

Submissions

We accept two types of submission:

- a) *Regular presentations*: a 10-15 minute oral presentation
- b) *Poster presentations* (a limited number of posters to be displayed in the Badia's Lower Loggia): participants can view posters and discuss them with presenters during the first lunch break of the Conference
