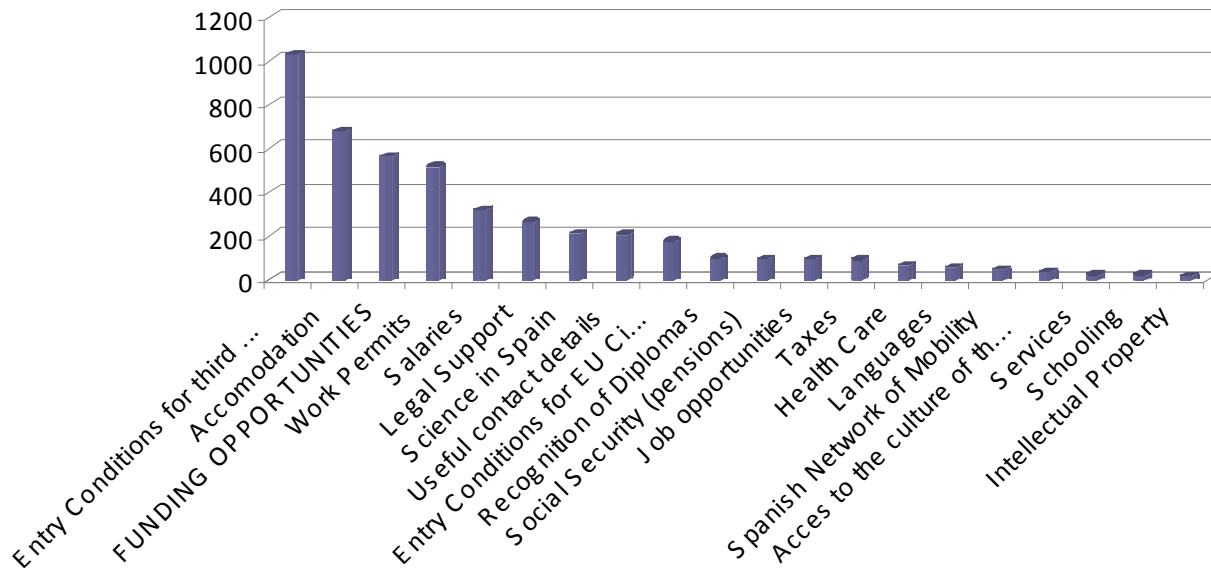

RAMÓN Y CAJAL

Aim:

“to offer experienced researchers the opportunity to join a Spanish institution to work in a research project of their choice”



Main Features:

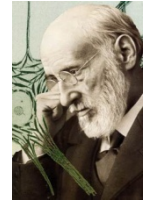
- Targeted Researchers: 2 – 10 years after PhD
- Additional rule: 24 months postdoc experience in centres different than the host institution
- Funding: from 33.250 for the researcher € + 15.000 € start up
- Duration: 5 years



RAMÓN Y CAJAL

Evaluation Criteria:

- CV (80%)
- Research Project (20%)



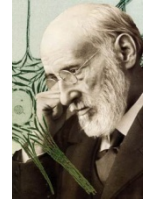
Status and Call Process: Closed for 2009

- Application Timing: 29/01 – 19/02/09 (deadline)
- Preliminary results June
- Final results September / October
- Starting date for the contracts from November on
- 233 positions for 2009 call
- Funding amount: 44.000.000€



RAMÓN Y CAJAL

Some Data:



- 7 calls since 2001
- Around 3000 beneficiaries
- 15,5% of funding assigned to SSH *
- 21% of SSH contracts are for foreign researchers *

JUAN DE LA CIERVA



Aim:

“to offer early postdocs the opportunity to join a Spanish research group to work in a specific project”

Main Features:

- Targeted Researchers: 0 – 3 years after PhD
- Additional rule: specific mobility rule
- Funding: from 25.250€
- Duration: 3 years



JUAN DE LA CIERVA



Evaluation Criteria:

- Candidate's CV (55%)
- Quality of the host research group (30%)
- Scientific quality of the proposed project (15%)

Status and Call Process: [Closed for 2009](#)

- Application Timing: 26/01 – 24/02/09 (deadline)
- Application to be submitted by institution
- Preliminary results July
- Final results October
- Starting date for the contracts from November on
- 350 positions planned for 2009 call



JUAN DE LA CIERVA

Some Data:



- Running from 2004
- 4 calls since then, 1400 beneficiaries
- 16,5% of total funding assigned to SSH *
- 28% of SSH contracts for foreign researchers *

JAE DOC



Aim:

“to offer researchers the opportunity to join a research group within the Spanish National Research Council (CSIC) to work in a research project”

Main Features:

- Targeted Researchers: 0 - 10 years after PhD
- Additional rule: PhD or 18 months postdoc experience outside CSIC
- Funding: 28.902,96 €
- Duration: 3 years



JAE DOC

Evaluation Criteria:

- Candidate's CV (50%)
- Quality of the host research group (30%)
- Scientific quality of the proposed project (20%)



Status and Call Process: OPEN

- Submitting period: 03/11/2009 – 02/12/2009
- Publication of eligible candidates: January 2010
- Contracts to start from April 2010 on
- 259 positions planned for 2009 call

Aim:

to attract top researchers to the Catalanian R&D System”

Main Features:

- Targeted Researchers: at least 4 years after PhD
- Additional rule: 4 years of international exposure
- Funding: salary of the researcher (\approx full professor)
- Duration: permanent position

Evaluation Criteria:

- Candidate's scientific excellence
- Leadership potential

Status: **CLOSED** for 2009. 30 positions per year





BEATRIU DE PINÓS



Agència

Aim:

“to allow postdocotral researchers to have a research stay in a Catalanian institution for 2 years”

Main Features:

- Targeted Researchers: 0 – 5 years after PhD
- Mobility rule: not connected with the hosting institution, in predoctoral or postdoctoral stages, unless 2 years of postdoctoral stay in a foreign institution.
- Funding: 26.555,03€
- Duration: 2 years

Status: **CLOSED** for 2009. Submission timing: 07/09/2009 – 29/09/2009.
40 positions per year.

Evaluation Criteria:

- Scientific Merit and research track
- Relevance of research topic and latest publications
- Concordance with Basque Research capabilities



FELLOWSHIPS

Main Features:



- Targeted Researchers: experienced researchers
- Additional rule: being active outside the Basque Country
- Funding: The gross income of each fellow will vary depending on:
- ✓ Length of the stay
 - ✓ Research track and experience
 - ✓ Interest fo the research project for the host research group
- Duration: from 6 to 12 months
- Status: **CLOSED**. Deadline for submission: 30/11/2009
10 positions

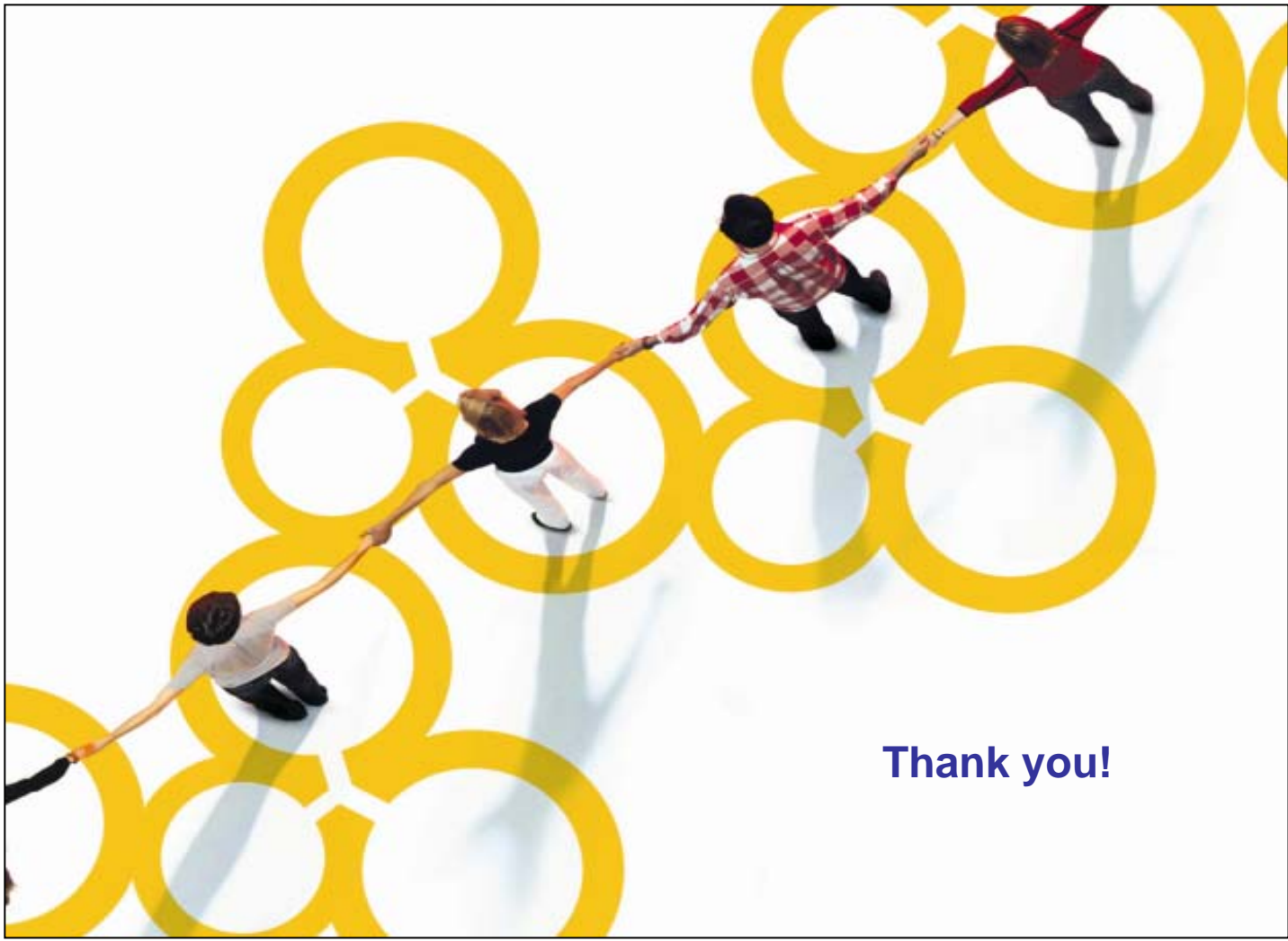
