Intent is a mental state that directs us to achieve a certain state of affairs, fulfil an objective, or satisfy a need. It is one of the sources of criminal and civil law responsibility (liability). In law, this mental state is attributed only to natural persons (humans) and artificial persons (e.g., corporations).

The purpose of this roundtable is to look at the legal concept of intent and to discuss its relation to liability through the interdisciplinary lens of other research fields. This relationship will be discussed from a variety of perspectives: neuroscientific, computational, legal-theoretical and philosophical.
