The conference aims to contribute to the debate on the European Union after the Lisbon Treaty ratification. Participants will include politicians and experts, representatives of think tanks, NGOs and media.

The Action Committee for European Democracy (ACED), also known as the Amato Group (after the former Prime Minister of Italy, Giuliano Amato), first met to contribute to the debate following the period of reflection before signing the Reform Treaty in Lisbon in December 2007. Recently, the Amato Group has assembled again to participate in the European debate on the promotion of the democratic values and transparency within the EU, on the cooperation between institutions at the European and national level, i.a. based on the subsidiarity principles, as well as on tightening the links between EU institutions and the Union's citizens.

ACED is a group of high-ranking politicians from various EU member states, supported by well-known European scholars and analysts. The project is funded by the Robert Bosch Stiftung and supported by the Robert Schuman Centre of Advanced Studies at the European University Institute, Florence. The European Institute of Public Administration also granted its support to the Warsaw conference.
