## FIND, BORROW, & REQUEST PURCHASES



- 1. Find your item on our Catalogue <u>opac.eui.eu</u> if it is not a journal or a reference-only book, you may borrow it
- 2. Pick it up from the shelf and come to the Loan Desk or check it out yourself with a self-check out terminal. Alternatively, click on "place hold" and have it delivered to Salviati, Schifanoia, La Fonte or Buontalenti: pick it up from the porter when you get the email: <a href="mailto:eui.eu/delivery">eui.eu/delivery</a>
  If what you need is kept in storage, click on "place hold" to have it delivered (book), or fill in a form at eui.eu/requestperiodical
- 3. You may borrow up to 60 items, and the standard length of loans is 30 days; DVDs are on loan for seven days
- 4. Renew your items up to 24 times on opac.eui.eu, then log into My Account (Login with your EUI personal Computing Account with your EUI username and password). Renewal is not possible if someone else has requested the book you borrowed
- 5. Overdue books accrue fines, keep an eye on your account and your email!
- 6. Return books to the Loan Desk or in one of the book-drop boxes at Salviati, Schifanoia, La Fonte or Buontalenti. Please contact <a href="mailto:euilib@eui.eu">euilib@eui.eu</a> if you have any issue with overdue items.

#### WHAT IS OPEN ACCESS?

An Open Access (OA) publication or dataset is immediately and freely available online, to read, download, copy, print, disseminate or search. As a publicly-funded institute, our aim is to increase the proportion of research publications and datasets in Open Access. The EUI Open Access Policy encourages its members to facilitate the dissemination of their published research by depositing it with Cadmus.

#### **CADMUS**

The EUI Research Repository, Cadmus, registers EUI members' academic publications and datasets produced during their time at the Institute and those based on research carried out here:

- 29,000 publication records
- 13,000 Open Access publications
- 3,381 theses of which 1,411 Open Access

#### **PUBLISH OPEN ACCESS**

The EUI has special agreements to allow its members to make their articles available in Open Access at no cost (waived APCs) with Cambridge University Press, Springer, Wiley and Elsevier.
