Description

The European and Transnational Governance Network (ETGN) brings together [seven European institutes](#) that offer top-of-the-market executive education for policy professionals. From July 4 – July 7, 2022 at the EUI School of Transnational Governance in Florence, the ETNG is organizing its first Summer School on Agile Governance. The four-day programme provides an in-depth guide to agile governance, defined as adaptive, human-centred, inclusive, multi-stakeholder and sustainable policy-making. What is included in the scholarship

The selected candidates will be expected to arrange their own travel to and out of Florence for the Summer School programme.

Eligibility

All interested candidates are invited to apply. Preference will be given to candidates with:

- At least five years of work experience in governance or related areas in the countries of the Western Balkans or the European Neighbourhood Policy.
- Clearly demonstrated interest in the topics at the intersection of governance and technology.
- A Master's degree in public policy, public administration, political science or a related field.
