

CEU Global Teaching Fellowship Program

Overview: Central European University (CEU) cultivates strategic partnerships with universities worldwide. Through the **Global Teaching Fellowship Program (GTFP)** advanced doctoral students and recent doctoral graduates from CEU research and teach at partner institutions under the framework of teaching fellowships. They bring with them not only strong academic credentials but also excellent academic practices and a diversity of perspectives.

GTFP partnerships always aim at supporting the missions of Partner Universities and their efforts towards internationalization, especially where such efforts involve diversification of curricula and increasing numbers of courses taught in English. In addition to fulfilling their academic responsibilities, the Fellows are encouraged to participate in other activities involving the local community in ways specified by the Partner's mission and its civic engagement.

About CEU: CEU is a densely international graduate-level university promoting high-level research and research-based teaching. It enrolls students and academic staff members from over 100 countries. CEU specializes in social sciences, humanities, law, public policy, and management, with several of CEU's departments, ranked among the first 50 or 100 in the world. CEU's doctoral programs are highly competitive; their graduates have become accomplished academics recognized for both their teaching and research.

The Fellowship Program:

The duration of the fellowships ranges from one semester to one full academic year. The Fellows are qualified to teach courses in one of the following broad areas: social sciences, humanities, law, economics, public policy, environmental sciences and policy, please find the whole list below.

Global Teaching Fellows can be either advanced doctoral candidates (in their third year of doctoral studies and beyond) or doctoral graduates who received their doctoral no earlier than 2 years prior to applying to GTFP, and who are selected in accordance with the criteria specified by the Partner University. They are integrated within the host departments, have a well-defined teaching load and academic status (visiting faculty, junior lecturer, teaching assistant, etc.), and may have other academic duties.

The CEU Center for Teaching and Learning (CTL) plays a crucial role in supporting the Global Teaching Fellowship Program. Through the Global Teaching Mentoring Program, CTL provides ongoing and sustained academic support to the Global Teaching Fellows in the area of higher education teaching and learning.

To strengthen partnerships, the international competitiveness and excellence CEU a member of CIVICA, the European University of Social Sciences, one of the European University Alliances supported by the European Commission —offers to invite CIVICA partner universities to GTFP. Calls for applications to GTFP positions will be distributed to all advanced doctoral candidates and recent graduates of members of CIVICA.
