The new Programme will focus on the connected fields of energy economics, energy law, energy regulation, energy geo-politics, energy sources, public opinion acceptability of energy policies; EU Energy Regulation, energy and environment; liberalisation and security of supply, the EU emission Trading Scheme, incentive-based regulation in the energy sector, institutional setting, market power, retail competition, network investments for the internal energy market.

The director of the Programme should have good research qualifications, organisational attitudes and experience, ability to communicate and to develop relations, excellent command of English, and knowledge of other languages.

The Director of the Programme will oversee scientific research on energy issues; organise workshops, seminars and training courses where academics and practitioners in regulatory institutions and in companies interested in energy can meet and debate; and supervise activities linked to the publication of research materials, handbooks and other support materials useful to the diffusion of information on energy issues.
