Within the framework of its Global Governance Programme, the EUI seeks applicants for the position of Programme Director on the 'Globalisation and International Monetary Economics' at the Robert Schuman Centre for advanced Studies.

The Programme on 'Globalisation and International Monetary Economics' will focus on the connected fields of International Economics, Monetary Economics, and Global Economic Imbalances. It will analyse issues such as the processes of monetary integration and globalisation, trade surplus/deficits and the volatility of exchange rates and capital movements, fiscal and monetary policy interactions, the reform of the international monetary system, and the regulation of the global economy through the G-8/G-20, the IMF, and the WTO.

The Director will be responsible for building the programme and over-seeing its components of applied research and policy activities.

The Director should have good research qualifications, organization attitudes and experience, ability to communicate and to develop relations, and fund raising experience.
