Department:	Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies, Migration Policy Centre (MPC)
Length of contract and % of full-time:	Full-time, starting as soon as possible until 31/03/19. The contract can be further renewed several times up to a total of 5 years (including the first contract period). The recruitment process of this vacancy notice is conditional upon the receiving of specific funds by the MPC.
Salary indication:	The basic net monthly salary after taxes is approx. 1,800 euro. Title of project:	Migration Policy Centre (MPC)
Job description:	Prospects for International Migration Governance (MIGPROSP) is a 5-year project (2014-19) funded by an Advanced Grant of the European Research Council awarded to Professor Andrew Geddes. MIGPROSP analyses the drivers of migration governance in four regions (Asia-Pacific, Europe, North America and South America). The project explores how and with what effects 'actors' (e.g. political leaders, policy-makers, NGOs) in migration governance systems in each of the four regions understand the causes and effects of international migration and how these, in turn, are shaped by understandings of key risks and uncertainties. The Research Assistant will conduct a study of the multi level governance of asylum-seeking migration in Italy through analysis of regional-, national- and EU-level responses to the issue.
