<b>Job description:</b>	<p>The ERC Consolidator Grant TechChange started in May this year and will last for five years. It will explore the effects of technological progress on the size and the structure of firms as well as on the workforce, in terms of employment and wage inequality.</p> <p>The candidate is expected to help develop a model of labour market job search and sorting between heterogeneous workers and firms, implement that model computationally, analyse relevant data to match the model to, and generate computational output that can be compared to actual data, and to undertake policy counterfactuals.</p>
