Job description:	The Middle East Directions Programme focuses on conflict dynamics, political economy and socio-political, security and religious transformations in the Middle East. It has a strong Syria component (Wartime and Post-Conflict in Syria), including research activities, regular dialogue between researchers, policymakers and practitioners, and training a network of Syrian researchers.
	Each Research Associate will conduct research on select issues relevant to the Wartime and Post-Conflict in Syria project, finalizing a research project report, a policy brief and an article analysis. The research will focus primarily on local governance, political economy and civic space in wartime and post-conflict environments.
	The Research Assistant will also participate in briefings/meetings with policymakers and practitioners, contribute to data collection for conflict sensitivity assessments and participate in methodological meetings, internal team meetings (monthly), thematic workshops and conferences.
