- Length of contract and % of full-time:** 3 years, full-time contract based in Florence (Italy).  
Expected starting date: January 2009. The basic net month salary for a full time contract will be approximately € 3.170 with family allowances and expatriation allowance (approx 16% of salary) where applicable.

- Title of project:** Return and Processes of Reintegration of Migrants in their Countries of Origin
- Job description:** **Please note that the position is conditional on the availability of funding for the project. A decision is expected by November 2008.**
- The incumbent will be in charge of managing a three-year cross-national research project focussing on the processes of reintegration of migrants and involving various partner institutions. She/he will be responsible for the day-to-day management and scientific coordination of the research activities at the level of the team. She/he will also be in charge of :
- Liaising between all the partners involved;
  - The timely achievement of the project deliverables, by providing scientific guidance;
  - Reporting, on a regular basis, on progress made;
  - Consolidating a genuine research network involving the project partners as well as external actors.

- A PhD in law, political science, economics, geography, demography;
  - Publications on migration issues, particularly on return and reintegration issues;
