Qualifications: The post is ideally suited for a PhD researcher or junior post-doc of any discipline with an interest in the cause and consequences of 1989, widely understood.

The candidate should preferably have everyday experience with bibliographic tools (if not with Zotero, then with tools like EndNote, ProCite) and be adept at using online databases and search tools already. Evidence of competence and experience with this, for your own research, should be included in the application.

It is not essential at this stage that the candidate already has experience in using Zotero, but candidates are strongly encouraged to try out Zotero to discover its features and advantages.

The application should include a one-page letter of motivation that highlights competence and experience with bibliographic tools, online searches and scholarly databases as well as a short curriculum vitae with essential academic data.
