- Title of project: Collective Action to Support the Reintegration of Return Migrants in their Countries of Origin (MIREM Project, <http://www.mirem.eu>)
- Job description: The MIREM project aims at analysing the factors and conditions that shape returnees' multifarious patterns and levels of participation in the development of their countries of origin with a view to facilitating their social and professional reintegration. Under the supervision of the scientific coordinator, the incumbent will contribute to research assistance (literature research, conference reports, bibliography) in the overall development of the project based at the RSCAS.

- have at least a university degree in the fields of social and political sciences, or applied economics, or law with a focus on migration studies (ideally on return issues);
