

## **Fellowship at the EUI library**

The European University Institute is an academic organization, founded in the early 1970's by the Member States of the European Union and charged with teaching and research at the highest academic level in the social and human sciences with special reference to Europe.

The EUI offers a fellowship to a librarian from a leading academic/research library, expert in electronic resources. The fellowship is available as of July 2005 for a duration up to 12 months.

The fellow will be closely associated with the work in the Library, and will collaborate in developing, organizing and monitoring electronic collections. He/she will be invited to take part in special projects and working groups and in dealing with policy issues such as preservation, metadata, licensing and web services.

The candidate should have a consolidated experience in that field and be at the forefront of electronic innovation and development, and possibly have an in depth knowledge of *Innovative's Millennium* Library software.

The fellowship's grant will be between €2500 and €3000 net, according to experience and seniority. Health and social security coverage can be provided if needed. The EUI Housing service gives support to the fellows in finding accommodation in Florence or near the EUI campus.
