OPEN COMPETITION ON THE BASIS OF QUALIFICATIONS AND TESTS**

Nature of post: 1 temporary post – grade C*1¹ – Clerk

Unit to which post is attached: Library

Duration of contract: three years, with possibility of renewal.

Description of duties: temporary staff member reporting to the responsible of the Library's periodicals and serials Unit. He/She will be in charge, of the following tasks:

- Processing of periodicals / serials acquisition and electronic resources: ordering, check-in and cataloguing.
- Correspondence with vendors, monitoring subscriptions, claims and related operations.
- Collection maintenance (weeding, binding management etc.)
- Maintenance of the library web pages related to periodicals and serials.
- Assistance to user services.

Qualifications required:

- Being a national of the European Union, or a national of third countries having acquired the status of long term resident on the basis of the European Council directive 2003/109/EC;
- A level of post-secondary education attested by a diploma;
- A degree in library and information science would constitute an advantage
- Working experience in a university or a research library;
- Familiarity with the use of computers and office automation software and experience with library IT applications/software.
- Ability to work as part of a multinational team;
- Good knowledge of English and Italian. Knowledge of a third language would be an asset.

Selection process:

Candidates short listed by the Selection Board will be invited for

- a language test
- a computing test
- an interview, enabling assessment of the candidate's ability to carry out the tasks of the post and to work in a European university institution

Assessment on the basis of qualifications and marking of tests:

Marking: 0 to 20 for the assessment on the basis of qualifications;

Marking: 0 to 20 for the language test;

Marking: 0 to 20 for the computing test;

Marking: 0 to 40 for the interview by the Selection Board.

The net monthly salary:

The net monthly salary after taxes is approx. euro 2,250. In addition, when conditions as laid down by the Statutes are applicable, there are family allowances - household allowance, dependent child allowance, education allowance – and expatriation allowance (approx. 16% of salary).
