Computing Service - Survey report, Year 2008-2009

Introduction to the Computing Service survey 2009

The CS user survey was carried out between May 27 and June 3, 2009

All researchers, fellows, academic personnel and staff of the EUI received an e-mail inviting them to fill in an online form with 23 questions: 17 concerning the IT services and 6 concerning the users role. Their anonymity was guaranteed.

The objective of the survey was to measure the user satisfaction level concerning many aspects of the IT services provided by the CS during the last academic year.

The survey was sent to 1030 registered members of the EUI. By its end 343 users had seen the form, 190 started the survey and 185 had fully completed the survey

The following report is summarizing the results and comparing them with those from the previous year (¹).

Among the many possible comparisons, visible in the following tables, there are few major indications:

- a) There is a general overall satisfaction level about the CS. This value increased by 15%, the users who were either satisfied or very satisfied moved from 70% to 85%.
- b) 10% of the users moved from EUI desktop PCs to laptops (or netbooks).
- c) There was a decrease of Windows XP users compensated by an increase of Windows Vista and Mac OS users.
- d) A significant improvement is registered concerning the availability/continuity of the IT services. When work obstructions are reported the major reasons concern: printer faults, Wi-Fi connection problem, and access to e-resources.
- e) There has been an improvement in satisfaction regarding the CS web pages, Internet access and printing facilities.
- f) The need of support for the research software, offered by the Lab Assistant, seemed to become less requested, as the number of users expressing "no opinion" increased significantly.

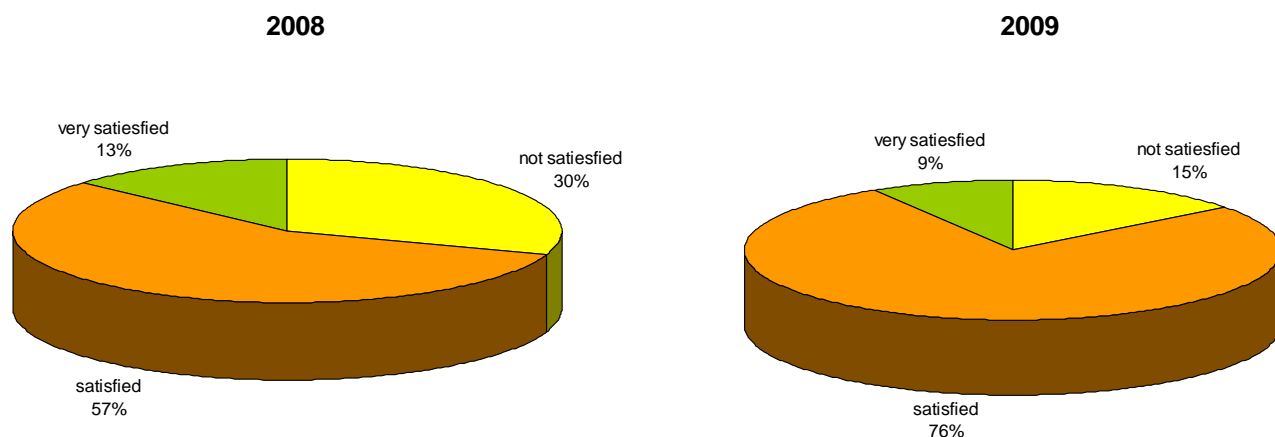
In conclusion, the main areas of enhancement, that are already the object of improvement activity or will be duly considered for the next year development plan, are: Mailbox Size, Disk size (G:drive), Printing hardware reliability, Wi-Fi coverage or ease of connection and Internet/download speed.

¹ Few questions were asked only in 2009, in this case the comparison was not possible and only 2009 data are reported.

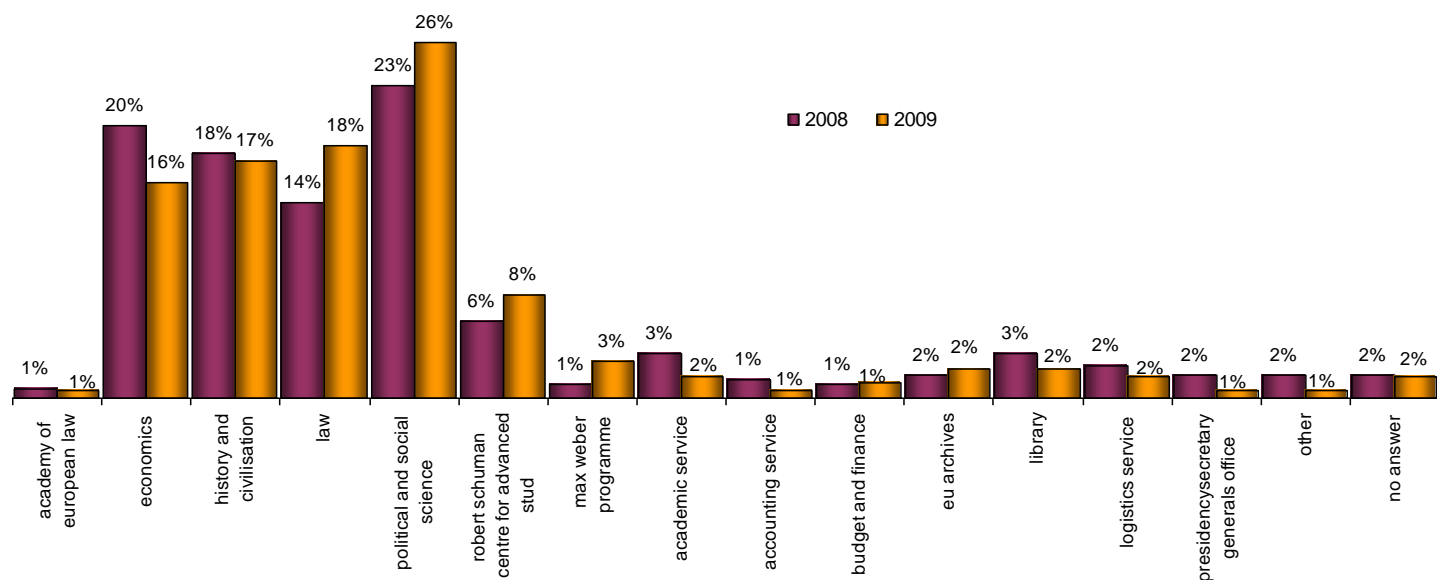

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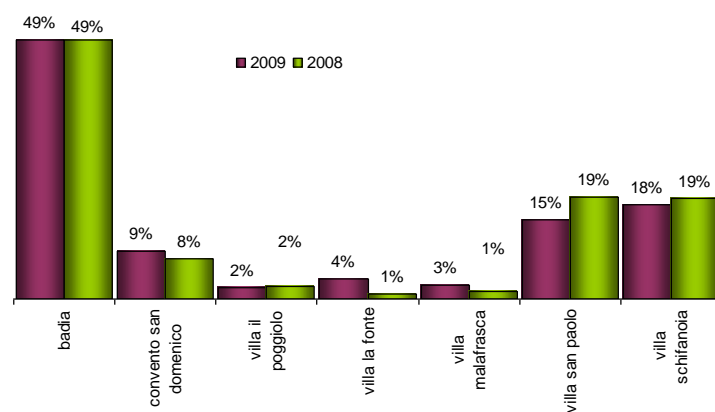
Figure 2: Summary of Answers

(Percentage with respect to the total by department, location and permanency, respectively)

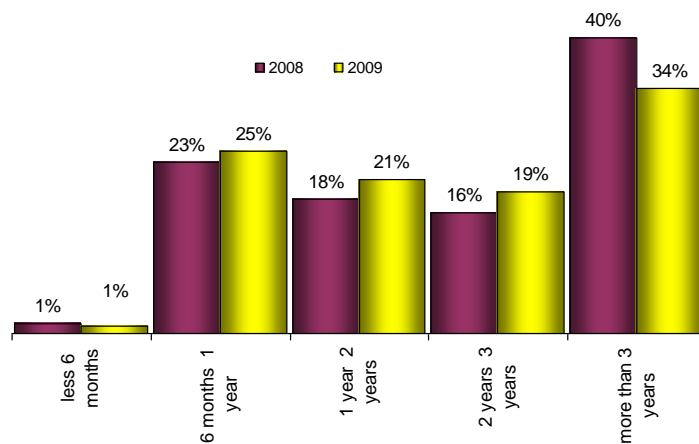
By department
