- Reduced programme in September
- Regular courses start in October
- All levels: A1 – C1/C2
- Courses for absolute beginners start **only** in October
- Progression: October – June

To complete a level you need to follow the whole academic year, but you can enrol for single terms.

October – June: Progression example

- Progression starting from zero:
 - 0: 1° term: October-December, A1.1
 - 2° term: January-March, A1.2
 - 3° term: April-June, A1.3

All levels follow this progression.
