Teachers should contact parents if child has a temperature over 37,5 .

The child must stay at home the following day also if she/he has no fever.

Other issues:

- 1) **Caughing**: child must be visited by the paediatrician to evaluate real health conditions.
- 2) **Vomiting and diarrhea**: child cannot attend the crèche in case of vomiting and diarrhoea and must remain at home for at least two days.
- 3) **Conjunctivitis**: child with purulent secretions from the eyes cannot attend the crèche and will be readmitted to the crèche only if he/she has completely recovered and with medical certificate (conjunctivitis is highly contagious).
- 4) **Exanthematous diseases**: Chicken pox, mumps, sixth disease, HFMD (hand, foot and mouth disease). Child must be visited by the paediatrician who will decide from time to time if he/she can be readmitted to the crèche.
- 5) **Stomatitis**: paediatrician must visit the child, who will be readmitted to the crèche only when he/she has completely recovered.
- 6) **Pediculosis**: Child with lice or only eggs cannot attend the crèche. Special shampoo must be used. The child can be readmitted to the crèche only if he/she has recovered, because pediculosis is highly contagious.
