

# **HIGH COUNCIL DECISION N. 1/2023**

### of 9 June 2023

amending the Conditions of Employment of
Teaching Staff of the European University
Institute (EUI) on compensations and allowances
to encourage participation in sponsored research
programmes and externally funded research

#### THE HIGH COUNCIL

Having regard to the Convention setting up a European University Institute, in particular Article 6(5)(c);

Having regard to the Conditions of Employment of Teaching Staff of the EUI (CETS) laid down by High Council Decision No. 7/2014 of 5 December 2014;

Having regard to High Council Decision 2/2004 of 10 June 2004 introducing compensations and allowances to encourage participation in sponsored research programmes and externally funded research;

Having regard to High Council Decision No. 03/2011 of 3 June 2011 revising articles 1 and 3 of High Council Decision No. 2/2004 of 10 June 2004 introducing compensation and allowances to encourage participation in sponsored research programmes and externally funded research (Director(s) of Research);

Having regard to the EUI Strategy 2019-2024, the principles of which were approved at the EUI High Council meeting of 7 June 2019;

Having consulted the Executive Committee on 10 May 2023;

### Whereas:

- (1) Recent and previous strategic reviews on the EUI have placed great emphasis on creating the right incentives to reward the ability to attract externally funded research projects;
- (2) These efforts have resulted in an increasing need to appoint directors for these externally funded research projects;
- (3) There is a need to guarantee that research activities do not hamper other activities such as teaching, supervision and other tasks in a Department;

- (4) Simplification of the procedure in this field will allow for the adoption of a number of implementing provisions within appropriate time limits;
- (5) It is important to ensure as far as possible a uniform implementation of the provisions for the appointment of academic contract holders;
- (6) Financial incentives will be subject to the EUI taxation system.

#### HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

#### Article 1

Article 29c of the CETS shall be replaced by the following:

## Article 29c Project Director

- 1. Where a member of the teaching staff devotes considerable effort to developing and managing large externally funded research programmes, they may be appointed as a Project Director by the President after consulting with the Head of the relevant Academic Unit.
- 2. Project Directors shall be appointed for a period of up to five years. In accordance with the same procedure, the appointment may be renewed on one or more occasions.
- 3. For the period acting as Project Director, a contract holder shall, upon his or her choice and request, be entitled to either:
  - a) A monthly allowance equal to 5% of his or her basic monthly salary, or
  - b) A one-year extension to the full-time professorial contract per year as Project Director up to the maximum period of service as set out in paragraph 4 of this decision.
- 4. The application of paragraph 3 cannot lead to a professorial contract exceeding 12 years.

## Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
