

HIGH COUNCIL DECISION N. 2/2023

of 9 June 2023

Establishing the grant terms for the researchers admitted to the 4th year in the calendar year 2024

THE HIGH COUNCIL

Having regard to the Convention setting up a European University Institute, in particular Article 6 (6) (b) and Article 17;

Having regard to the High Council decision of 12 December 2002 establishing the recruitment of a 4th-year completion grant funded by the budget of the Institute;

Having regard to the Terms and Conditions for the Payment of the Fourth-Year EUI Completion Grant, June 2023;

Having regard to President's Decision No. 55/2022 of 13 December 2022 establishing the grant terms for the researchers admitted to the 4th year in the academic year 2022-2023, and the preceding President's Decisions on the same topic;

Having regard to the opinion of Budget and Finance Committee of 28 April 2022 concerning the amount of the medical insurance premium;

Having regard to the opinion of Budget and Finance Committee of 27 April 2023 concerning the level of the 4th year grant;

Having regard to Articles 7.3 and 7.4 of the Academic Rules and Regulations for the Doctoral and Master of Research Programmes as amended by Academic Council Decision N° 1/2023 of 18 January 2023;

Whereas:

- (1) Given the increase in the level of inflation it is important to revise the level of the 4th year grant for 2024 paid by the budget of the Institute;
- (2) There is a need to adjust the monthly household and family allowance which have remained unchanged since 2019;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

The monthly 4th year grants is set at € 1,505.

Article 2

The monthly household allowance for dependent spouse or partner is set at € 265.

Article 3

The monthly family allowance for each dependent child is set at € 265.

Article 4

The monthly premium covering the expenses of the medical insurance will be set yearly by the service provider chosen further to the call for tender for the researcher and his/her dependent family members (spouse/partner and children).

Article 5

The grant includes an annual travel allowance, covering a round trip from Florence to the country of origin, for the researcher and his/her dependent family members (spouse/partner and children) as laid out in regulations on travel for research missions of researchers and candidate researchers.

Article 6

This Decision enters into force on 1st January 2024.
