Executive Order on registration of special provisions for listed buildings owned by the state of local authorities

Pursuant to Act No. 213 of 23 May 1979 on preservation of buildings, section 13 (3), cf. subsection (2), the following is laid down:

1 – (1) Pursuant to section 12 (1) of the Preservation of Buildings Act, an owner who is refused permission to demolish a listed building, may require that the property be taken over by the state in return for compensation. This rule shall not apply to listed buildings which belong to the state, local authorities, churches, clerical incumbents, or public foundations, or which after have belonged to any of these after 1 January 1980, cf. section 13 (2) of the Act.

2 – (1) Prior to handing over a listed building owned by the state or local authorities to other owners than those mentioned in section 1, 2nd clause, the owner in question shall enter into the title register a notice to the effect that section 12 (1) of the Preservation of Buildings Act shall not apply to the property. The provision shall be observed by all holders of rights in the property, irrespective of when such rights were established.

3 – (1) This Executive Order shall enter into force on 1 January 1980.
