Executive Order on supervision of walls of stone and earth and ancient relics or monuments

Pursuant to section 29 o (5) of Act No. 473 of 7 June 2001, the Museum Act, as most recently amended by Act No. 454 of 9 June 2004, the following is laid down:

Part 1

Supervision of walls of stone and earth and ancient relics and monuments

1 – (1) The Heritage Agency of Denmark may enter into agreements with museums subsidised by the state to the effect that they are to be in charge of the supervision of walls of stone and earth and ancient relics or monuments on behalf of the Agency.

(2) The parts of the supervision of which the museums are to be in charge shall be stipulated in the agreements mentioned in subsection (1).

(3) The supervisory tasks of the museums shall be performed against payment under the terms of the agreement, cf. subsection (1).

Part 2

Entry into force

2 – (1) This Executive Order shall enter into force on 1 January 2007. Section 1 (1) of the Executive Order shall enter into force on 8 July 2006, however, as agreements entered into do not become effective until 1 January 2007.
